Well done to everyone who took part in our Comic Relief "Let's Be Superheroes" fundraising event today!




It was fantastic to see so many creative costumes on show.

Multi-Active are so pleased to announce we will be Essendon's Wrap Around Before and After School Club once again from March 8th 2021. The Base After school sports clubs will begin from 13th April 2021!

Multi-Active are a childcare provider who operate across Beds/Herts/Cambs and Essex working with schools to provide Wrap Around Care and School Holiday Services. For more information about Multi-Active you can visit our website at www.multi-active.co.uk

From 8th March 2021 we will be providing:


