#### Welcome

A very warm welcome back to all our families and a big welcome to all our new families at Essendon C of E Primary School as we start the new academic year and the next steps along our learning journey.

## **Homewood Class Teacher Update**

For this year only, Homewood Class will be having two teachers as part of the teaching team. In the mornings, Homewood Class will be taught in year groups. Year 2 will be taught by Mrs Jones and Year 1 by Mrs Goddard, and then the whole class will come back together in the afternoon to be taught by Mrs Jones. Mrs Jones will be overall KS1 Lead. This means that the year groups that have felt the most impact on their early learning from the Covid lockdowns will be able to learn at their own pace ensuring the foundations of reading, writing and maths are fully embedded at this very important stage.

#### Save the Date

Each class teacher will be holding a 30 minute information session in their classroom to outline the curriculum and give any messages to parents and carers. These will be at 3:30pm on: Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September for Homewood; Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September for Pantherswood; Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> September for Warrenwood and Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September for Harefield.

### Drop-off and Pick-up.

Remember arrival time is 8:40am to 8:50am and pick up is 3:15pm for all classes. Entrances and exits are the same as last term, if anyone arrives after 8:50am please come to the main school entrance. All arrivals after 9am will be marked as late and we can have a conversation to support with this.

In the morning a quick message to the adult at the door is fine, a longer chat needs to be booked in with the teacher after school.
